The Manchester Grand Hyatt San Diego – a stunning waterfront hotel located in the heart of downtown San Diego. It offers breathtaking views of the bay and is just steps away from top attractions like Petco Park and the Seaport Village. For the first time in history, LPA is going back to a conference hotel from the past. We loved the Manchester Grand Hyatt so much in 2014, that we decided to finally repeat a property – and it's completely worthy of the repeat! The hotel features updated, spacious quest rooms and there are a variety of dining options, including the waterfront Sally's Fish House & Bar. Relax at the rooftop pool with panoramic views of San Diego Bay, and ponder checking out the 24-hour StayFit fitness center,...or just stay at the pool for a little while longer. The room rate is \$189.00 per night plus tax (approximately 13%). You must register with the LPA conference prior to making hotel reservations. After completing your LPA registration online, the system will link you directly to the hotel reservation site. If you register online, or by mail, then you will be sent an email confirmation receipt with an access code to make your hotel reservation. Please note: after making your reservation, the Manchester Grand will charge your credit card or bank card with the first night's deposit to guarantee your reservation.



Transportation Information

AIRPORT & SHUTTLE INFORMATION:

SAN DIEGO (SAN) AIRPORT INFORMATION

San Diego International Airport (SAN) is the closest airport, approximately 3 miles from the hotel. The Grand Hyatt San Diego does not provide shuttle services; however, there are many other transportation options available.

Taxis: Estimated to be around \$15 - \$25 for a one-way trip to the Hyatt from the airport. Many companies provide taxicab service at San Diego International Airport. If you need a taxi, simply follow the signs leading to the Transportation Plazas. A Customer Service Representative will place you with the first available taxi, unless you specify a particular taxicab company.

Uber, Lyft, and Other Rideshare Options: : Several companies offer rideshare services at San Diego International Airport. The following companies are currently permitted to operate at the airport: Lyft, Uber, Opoli, and Wingz.

Designated rideshare passenger pickup locations are listed below:

- Terminal 1: Travelers will exit baggage claim and use the new pedestrian crosswalk, which has a traffic light to provide access to the ridesharing pickup area. See signage for assistance.
- Terminal 2: Upon exiting baggage claim, use the main crosswalk to Transportation Plaza. Ridesharing pick-up is located in the second lane on the right. See signage for assistance.

OTHER AIRPORT INFORMATION

Santa Ana Airport (SNA) is approximately 85 miles from the Hyatt, while Long Beach Airport (LGB) is around 110 miles away.

AIRPORT ASSISTANCE

TSA Cares provides information on security procedures aimed to help passengers with disabilities, medical conditions and individuals needing additional assistance to better prepare for the security screening process.

TSA has modified procedures to ensure that your screening experience is smooth and seamless. For information, please check out their brand new comprehensive website here: <u>TSA CARES</u>

TSA PreCheck can make the airport security screening process smoother and faster. That's mainly because members can access lines that tend to be shorter and do not have to remove shoes, belts, 3-1-1 liquids, laptops, or light jackets.

REFUNDS AND CANCELLATIONS:

Refunds for registration fees, minus a \$50 processing fee, will be granted for all requests received on or before June 1, 2025. Event fees will only be refunded prior to June 1st if LPA is able to resell the event tickets. All credit card fees are the responsibility of the registrant. Refund requests must be sent in writing to the conference management committee by email at <u>nationalconference.lpa@gmail.com</u>. Refund requests made after June 1, 2025 will not be honored. Emergencies and illness will be considered on a case-by-case basis. There will be no on-site refunds for registration fees, events, or tours. Registrants who do not cancel prior to June 1st and do not attend are responsible for the full registration fees and activity fees. Tickets for activities may be traded, sold, or given away at the discretion of the ticket holder. LPA takes no responsibility for trading, selling, or exchange of tickets. A "Conference Notice Board" will be provided on-site, near registration, for the purpose of posting information and individual ticket exchanges or sales.

UNACCOMPANIED MINORS:

Unaccompanied minors (17 years and under) attending the conference without their parents or legal guardian must have an identified conference guardian. The Temporary Guardian Form must be included with their registration form or your packet will be returned to you as incomplete and unregistered. Please note: unaccompanied minors must complete their own individual LPA Registration and may not be added on as a guest to their guardian's registration.

MEDIA AT THE 2025 LPA CONFERENCE:

The Conference Management Committee, the LPA Public Relations Director, Jennifer Crumly, and the hotel management must approve all press and media requests at the LPA National Conference by June 15, 2025. Press credentials must be worn at all times.

If any members have questions or concerns, please contact Jennifer Crumly at jennifer.crumly@lpaonline. org. By signing the registration form you are signing a release to be shown on camera for pictures and video taken by LPA or by media at the conference. LPA reserves the right to revoke any press credentials if it is determined that it is not in LPA's best interest to continue granting access.

LPA CONCIERGE DESK:

This year, LPA will have a Concierge Desk located within the registration room. LPA Concierge volunteers will be able to answer your questions about the local area, the conference schedule and activities, and any other questions you may have during the week. LPA Conference swag will also be available at the LPA Concierge desk - check it out!

SALE OF GOODS AT CONFERENCE:

The selling of any items; i.e. glow sticks, pins, food, etc., other than as a registered expo vendor during expo hours at the 2025 LPA National Conference is prohibited, unless otherwise authorized by the conference committee.

CONFERENCE BADGE:

The official conference registration badge will be required at all events. Security guards and conference staff will be checking for conference badges at all functions. If you lose your badge, a replacement badge can be obtained for \$20. Your conference badge will function as your admission ticket to all general events, dances, and workshops, which do not require an additional fee. Events requiring an additional fee include the children's room, awards banquet, off-site trips, etc.

GREAT ADVICE FOR ATTENDEES:

This packet is designed to tell you what is included at the LPA Conference but there are several things not included that you should take note of:

- You are responsible for your hotel room (must be 18+ to check-in) and any taxes or costs associated with it. You are also responsible for your own food.
- If you are going to have roommates, make sure you know who is paying for which expenses beforehand.
- Be sure to have money for transportation, tips, and other incidentals.
- Check with your bank before leaving home about branch ATMs in San Diego or what fees you could incur.
- Great tools to bring with you are cell phones /walkie- talkies for all members of the family, a highlighter to mark your conference book, a battery pack or two for charging that phone/camera, and personal business cards. You will be meeting many people and making new connections – a family or individual business card is a quick way to exchange information easily.

CONFERENCE REGISTRATION CHANGES:

We will attempt to process any registration changes (additions/deletions) through June 1, 2025. After June 1st, all changes must be made on-site. All events are subject to selling out at any time. If you need to make a change to your registration once it is submitted contact the Conference Management Committee at nationalconferencereg.lpa@gmail.com (please allow 48 hours for a response for our conference volunteers. If emailing the first week of registration, please give the conference volunteers a week to answer emails, due to the high volume of communication that particular week.).

ACCESSIBLE TRANSPORTATION NEEDS FOR OFF-SITE TRIPS:

It is imperative that you indicate special transportation needs when you register if you will be going on one or more off-site events or tours. Please be sure to indicate if you use a wheelchair, scooter, collapsible scooter, cane or crutches. Please also indicate whether you are able to transfer from your wheelchair or scooter. Providing accessible transportation for events is contingent upon you indicating your needs on the registration form. The only reason LPA asks for more information regarding accessibility needs is to ensure the correct type of transportation will be provided, and your information will not be shared otherwise. Failure to provide this information will result in limited accessible transportation.

EVENTOS EN ESPAÑOL:

NON-DISCRIMINATION:

LPA does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, age, national origin, and diagnosis or disability status in its programs and activities, with respect to admission, access, treatment, benefit and/or employment. In addition, LPA does not condone any form of harassment.

NO SMOKING:

Please respect your fellow LPA members with health conditions. The Manchester Grand Hyatt is smoke- free. Designated smoking areas are located outside the building.

PROHIBITED CONDUCT:

LPA members and other attendees of LPA functions may be disciplined for grievous behavior during or related to an LPA function, including the National Conference by eviction, membership probation, revocation of membership, and/or other actions deemed reasonable. Any official action by LPA does not preclude legal recourse by the hotel or outside entity. Prohibited behavior includes, but is not limited to, illegal use of alcohol and/or drugs, destruction of hotel or private property and harassment.

AGE VERIFICATION:

For all on-site and off-site events that require participants to be over 21 years of age, registrations will be checked against LPA records. You may be required to provide identification at any time.

LPA's Alcohol Policy

ALCOHOL USE UNDER AGE 18:

The legal drinking age in California is 21 years old. If it is determined by LPA, hotel security or police that an individual under the age of 21 is under the influence of alcohol at an LPA National Conference, then that individual may not be allowed to attend a LPA National Conference without at least one parent or their legal guardian in attendance until age 21. They will not be allowed to designate a Conference Guardian. Parents will be contacted immediately regarding the individual's alcohol consumption and resulting behavior. If parents are in attendance at the National Conference, then the underage individual shall be prohibited from attending the next National Conference. If the person has a second infraction, with or without their parents present, before they are 18 years of age, then they will not be allowed to attend LPA National Conference until they are 21.

ALCOHOL USE BETWEEN AGES 18 AND 21 – ZERO TOLERANCE:

Individuals between the ages of 18 and 21 who are determined by LPA, hotel security or police to be under the influence of alcohol at an LPA National Conference event shall not be allowed to attend another LPA Conference until age 21. Individuals may be immediately removed from the current Conference site. Additionally, LPA will consult with hotel security and/or local law enforcement agencies on reporting the underage consumption of alcohol.

PROVIDING ALCOHOL TO MINORS:

Little People of America, its officers and Conference Committee, will not tolerate anyone of any age providing or purchasing alcohol for minors. This includes the purchase of alcohol in bars or clubs, cash bars or providing of alcohol at individual parties in private hotel rooms. If an individual is found to be in violation: they will be reported to the hotel security and local law enforcement officials for the legal action of the host Conference site. They will be removed from the current LPA Conference and will not be allowed to attend the next two LPA Conferences. A committee consisting of not less than the following individuals: LPA Executive Officers, the current LPA Conference Chair, and their Current or past District Director and/or Chapter President will determine their attendance at National Conferences thereafter. They may also lose their membership to LPA for an undetermined length of time.

DISRUPTIVE BEHAVIOR:

If a person of any age participates in the destruction or damage of any public or private property, disorderly conduct, verbal or physical fighting, harassment or abuse of individuals while at an LPA National Conference, that person will be subjected to disciplinary action by the local civil authorities and/or LPA Executive Committee and/or Board of Directors.







MEDICAL MEETING SCHEDULING GUIDELINES:

- Scheduling begins May 15, 2025 and will END June 15, 2025 until on site. No meetings will be scheduled before May 15, 2025. (Feel free to fill out the form in beforehand, but the doctors' schedules will not be confirmed until after that date).
- Meetings with specific physicians are made on a first-come, first-served basis. Due to the tight schedule of the doctors, you will be unable to see two doctors of the same specialty. (Only 1 appointment per specialty).
- You must be already registered for the LPA conference in order to be obtain an individual meeting with a provider.
- We will confirm your meeting before the conference within 2 to 4 weeks before arrival. Please be patient - your medical meeting is very important to us, but sometimes the doctors' schedules are still being determined.
